GLASCOCK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MET IN A REGULAR SESSION IN THE GLASCOCK COUNTY COURTROOM. MEMBERS PRESENT WERE AUDREY CHALKER, CHAIRMAN, BARBARA HADDEN, VICE-CHAIRMAN, LORI BOYEN, COMMISSIONER.

Chairman Chalker called the meeting to order and welcomed guests.

Jeremy Kelley gave the invocation.

Chairman Chalker led the pledge of allegiance.

Vice Chairman Hadden made motion seconded by Commissioner Boyen to adopt agenda. Motion carried.

Debbie Williford read minutes from the July 1 regular meeting and the July 24 called meeting. Commissioner Boyen noted a correction to the July 1 minutes. TSplost funds will be used to purchase vehicle instead of Splost funds. Commissioner Boyen made motion to accept minutes with correction, seconded by Vice Chairman Hadden. Motion carried.

Vice Chairman Hadden made motion seconded by Commissioner Boyen to accept financial report. Motion carried.

Braswell Park was the next topic on the agenda. Commissioners discussed postponing the contract to have time to possibly get specific donations from Jefferson and Washington EMC. Suggested date for work to start was January 2, 2015.

This was the final hearing on closing of Mt. Nebo Church Rd. Chairman Chalker called for discussion. There was none. Vice Chairman Hadden made the motion seconded by Commissioner Boyen to close the road. Motion carried.

Splost will give out in April of 2015. There was discussion about attempting to promote a "YES" vote for Splost on the November ballot. It was noted that if Splost did not pass that it could not be addressed for a period of two years.

A written Sheriff's report was provided by Jeremy Kelley as well as an update on the Dodge Charger. Cost on charger to be approximately \$1400.00.

A written report was provided by Dale Reed.

After discussion on miscellaneous topics, Vice Chairman Hadden made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Boyen. Motion carried.
